The other reason is a practical one in that I would like to appeal to you for a year-end contribution to our organization. We are a 501 C-3 non-profit organization and your donations will be tax-deductible. 
We are an organization with fifteen years of healthy financial track record of integrity that engages in education and disaster relief in China. We are unique in that we have very low administrative costs (if at all in China) as we work through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Nationally for our educational projects in Yunnan. All earmarked funds will go directly to the beneficiaries. Our operational expenses stateside are very low and are raised separately. So every dollar that you designate to us will go directly for that purpose.

Two weekends ago, we were very busy in fundraising activities in San Francisco and in the Los Angeles areas. We understand the U.S. economy has not improved yet and not to our surprise, our fundraising results were not to our expectations. To my shock this year, we have fallen way short of our projected budget by about 85% (about \$280,000). This will first affect our on-going educational projects that we renew with the local schools on a yearly basis. What this boils down to is that worthy teachers and students will not be able to get the basic education that they desperately need. Students will not be able to attend classes when the new term comes. Worse yet, we will not be able to pay our administrative staff's salary. I do not want this to happen and as a Faith-based organization, I believe God will mobilize the needed resources and to use us to realize His vision.

As a recipient of this letter, I know you have been a supporter of CRRS. May I request that you send in your most generous donations soon? I have promised the local leaders in the rural areas of Yunnan (near Vietnam) that I will work along with our U.S. leaders to work hard to raise funds this year.

Can you help us succeed by making your contribution as generous as you can? Every dollar goes a long way in China. Please also remember the disaster relief efforts in Sichuan as the recovery is not yet complete. We have some worthy projects that require your financial help as well.
